## 2018-2019 STUDENT/TEACHER/PARENT AGREEMENT

Since classes meet only once a week for one hour and 15 minutes, everyone must cooperate in order to make this a positive learning experience. Parents, please go over this agreement with your child. Be sure that your child understands what is expected of him/her. Then, sign the form and have your child sign the form. Return the signed agreement with your registration form. (Note: Individual teachers will establish their individual classroom rules.)

I understand that the room and desk I am using does not belong to me. I will not use/play with things that are not mine. I will not open the desk that I am using, since it belongs to someone else. I will respect the property of others.

All my electric devices will be turned off or muted and put away during class time. If I do not follow this procedure, I understand that the electronic device will be taken from me and the first encounter the teacher will take the device and return it at the then of that class, if it happens a second time my parent(s) will have to contact the Director of Religious Education to retrieve my device. The only exception to this will be if the device is used in the case of an emergency.

I will follow the classroom rules that are set by my teacher. I will show respect for him/her by not talking when he/she is talking.

I will respect the other students in class with me.

I will remain in my classroom unless I have permission to leave the room by the teacher. If I must leave the room, I will not wander through the halls, disturbing other classes.

I am here to learn about Jesus, God and the Catholic Church. I will do my best to be open to listening to the Word of God and learning the teachings of Jesus and the Church.

I will follow along in class and will try to do my work to the best of my ability.

If I disobey and break the rules, I know the consequences:

- † First offense: verbal warning by the teacher.
- † Second Offense: sent to the office for the remainder of the class.
- † Third Offense: written warning sent to the parents/guardians.
- † Fourth Offense: meeting with parents/guardians, teacher, student and Director of Religious Education.
- † Fifth Offense: removal from the program.
